IN THE MATTER OF IMPOSING) Ordinance 2024-1
ADDITIONAL FEES FOR CUSTOMER)
FAILING TO REPAIR SEWER INTRUSION)
AND REPLACING ORDINANCE 2017-1-12)

The above matter having come before the Board of Directors at a regularly scheduled meeting on February 6th, 2024.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Miles Crossing Sanitary Sewer District Board of Directors has imposed additional fees for customers who have been informed of Intrusion and Infiltration from their residence, business, or other place of occupancy, into the Miles Crossing collection system and have failed to make corrective action within a reasonable time frame, as agreed upon by the property owner and the District. This Ordinance will repeal / replace R&O 2017-1-12.

If a customer has failed to make noticeable progress towards the correction of I/I at the property in question within a reasonable timeframe, a fee of \$9.50 per 1,000 gallons introduced into the collection system as determined by the District Monitor System OR a fee of \$100, whichever is greater. These fees are in addition to the standard base rate and will be billed as part of the monthly statement.

These fees are used to help offset the costs of sending additional flows to the City of Astoria for treatment. These fees will be removed and the rate returned to normal once the Miles Crossing Sanitary Sewer District Board of Directors feel that adequate progress has been made towards the repair of the sewer intrusion.
